

Pennsbury Instrumental Music Boosters Constitution and Bylaws

Constitution

Article I

Name

The name of this organization is the Pennsbury Instrumental Music Boosters.

Article II

Objectives

The objectives of the Pennsbury Instrumental Music Boosters, a non-profit organization, are:

Section I: To arouse and maintain an enthusiastic interest in the various phases of the Pennsbury Instrumental Music Program,

Section II: To lend all possible support, both moral and financial, to the instrumental music ensembles, and to provide social and other programs as well as awards for instrumental musical ensemble personnel,

Section III: To cooperate with those in charge of the Pennsbury Instrumental Music Programs, School Administration and the School Board, to the end that these instrumental musical ensembles are brought to and kept at the highest degrees of efficiency. To build and maintain an organization which will help promote the general activities of the Pennsbury Instrumental Music Department.

Article III

Membership

Section I: The membership of this organization shall not be limited. Anyone interested in furthering the aims of the organization shall be eligible for membership.

Section II: Yearly dues shall be an amount specified and approved by the membership.

Section III: A member in good standing is one who has paid yearly dues.

Article IV

Officers and Appointed Positions

Section I: The elected officers:

- must be members in good standing of the organization ,
- will have a child who participates in two instrumental music department programs, those programs including marching band, concert band, symphonic winds, 9th grade band, jazz lab band, concert jazz band, indoor guard, indoor drum line, and orchestra in the year which they would serve,
- and shall consist of a President, Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Section II: The appointed committee chairs and other position holders shall be members in good standing.

Section III: The executive board will have the power to establish and dissolve committees to meet organization goals.
